**UPDATE ALLOWANCES SUMMARY AER9****EXHIBITION EMPLOYEE ALLOWANCES:**

<b>CLAUSE</b>	<b>ALLOWANCE TYPE</b>	<b>NEW AMOUNT</b>
<b>15.2</b>	<b>Protective clothing and equipment</b>	Reimbursement of protective clothing (oilskins, gumboots, overalls, goggles, safety boots, etc) on proof of purchase unless employer provides them
<b>15.4</b>	<b>Meal Allowance</b>	<b>\$10.98</b> or a meal where employee is required to work two or more hours overtime immediately after completing ordinary hours
<b>15.5</b>	<b>First Aid Allowance</b>	<b>\$15.67</b> per week or <b>\$0.41</b> per hour where employee appointed to perform first aid duties
<b>15.6</b>	<b>Uniform Allowance</b>	Reimburse employee for cost of purchase of uniform unless employer supplies uniform. <b>\$1.32</b> per rostered day up to a maximum of <b>\$6.62</b> per week where the employee launders their own uniform
<b>15.7</b>	<b>Transport Allowance</b>	<b>\$0.78</b> per kilometer where the employer requests the employee to use their own vehicle for travelling on the employer's business
<b>15.8</b>	<b>Tool Allowance</b>	<b>\$13.23</b> per week for a Tradesperson (other than a Carpenter) or <b>\$25.80</b> per week for Carpenters where employee is required to provide their own tools
