### UPDATE ALLOWANCES SUMMARY BR10

#### ALLOWANCES:

CLAUSE	ALLOWANCE TYPE	AMOUNT
18.1(a)	Vehicle Allowance	<b>\$0.76</b> per kilometer where the employer requires the employee to use their own vehicle in the course of their employment
18.1(b)	Motorcycle Allowance	<b>\$0.38</b> per kilometer where the employer requires the employee to use their own vehicle in the course of their employment
18.2	First Aid Allowance	<b>\$15.67</b> per week or <b>\$0.41</b> per hour where employer appoints an employee as a first aid attendant
18.3	Working Late	Employer to provide transport home
18.4	Uniform Allowance	<b>\$1.60</b> per rostered day up to a maximum of <b>\$7.83</b> where the employee launders their uniform
57.1	Removal Allowance	If an employee is appointed or transferred to a theatre and the employer requires the employee to reside in a particular suburb, town or State, the cost of removal shall be paid to the employee
57.2	Working away from usual place of work	If a weekly employee whilst travelling is required to provide their own board and lodging, they will be paid an allowance of <b>\$79.91</b> per day to a maximum of <b>\$399.55</b> per week.
57.3	Zone Managers – Zone 1	Managers in central city areas of a capital city, Newcastle or any cinema regularly giving 3 or more performances daily receive <b>\$42.14</b> per week for each additional theatre supervised to a maximum of <b>\$252.93</b> per week.
57.3	Zone Managers – Zone 2	Managers of drive-in theatres & non-Zone 1 cinemas receive <b>\$29.53</b> per week for each additional theatre supervised to a maximum of <b>\$178.04</b> .
