ALLOWANCES:

CLAUSE	ALLOWANCE TYPE	AMOUNT
18.1(a)	Vehicle Allowance	\$0.76 per kilometer where the employer requires the employee to use their own vehicle in the course of their employment
18.1(b)	Motorcycle Allowance	\$0.38 per kilometer where the employer requires the employee to use their own vehicle in the course of their employment
18.2	First Aid Allowance	\$16.18 per week or \$0.43 per hour where employer appoints an employee as a first aid attendant
18.3	Working Late	Employer to provide transport home
18.4	Uniform Allowance	\$1.60 per rostered day up to a maximum of \$7.83 where the employee launders their uniform
57.1	Removal Allowance	If an employee is appointed or transferred to a theatre and the employer requires the employee to reside in a particular suburb, town or State, the cost of removal shall be paid to the employee
57.2	Working away from usual place of work	If a weekly employee whilst travelling is required to provide their own board and lodging, they will be paid an allowance of \$81.88 per day to a maximum of \$409.41 per week.
57.3	Zone Managers – Zone 1	Managers in central city areas of a capital city, Newcastle or any cinema regularly giving 3 or more performances daily receive \$43.53 per week for each additional theatre supervised to a maximum of \$261.26 per week.
57.3	Zone Managers – Zone 2	Managers of drive-in theatres & non-Zone 1 cinemas receive \$30.50 per week for each additional theatre supervised to a maximum of \$183.91 .
