As Members may be aware, the Tasmanian State Budget was handed down last Thursday (26 May). LPA is disappointed that:

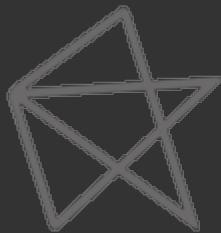
- The 2016–17 TAS State Budget did not include new live performance initiatives.
