



## LPA Summary: QLD Budget 2018–19

Dear Member,

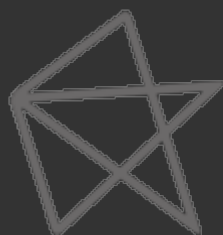
As Members may be aware, the Queensland State Budget 2018-19 was handed down yesterday (12 May).

The QLD Budget included the following funding commitments to benefit Queensland's live performance sector:

- **\$125m** over four years to build a **new performing arts venue** at the Queensland Performing Arts Centre.
- **\$8m** over four years to support the **Queensland Performing Arts Centre** in extending its programming reach across the State, investing further in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander performing arts and developing a musical theatre incubator.
- **\$3.3m** over two years to address **critical infrastructure** works at the Queensland Performing Arts Centre.
- **\$14m** over two years towards refurbishment of the Thomas Dixon Centre to provide **enhanced performance facilities for Queensland Ballet**.
