CPI Increase to PPCA Licences for Public Performance of Protected Sound Recordings & Exhibition of Music Video Clips

EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2017

Dear Member,

The Phonographic Performance Company of Australia Limited (PPCA) has advised that, consistent with their usual practice, they propose to **increase tariff rates based on the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI)** since the last increase (1 July 2016) for each respective tariff.

This will apply to all new licences and/or renewals from 1 July 2017, and generally equates to an increase of around 1.5%.

The full list of CPI adjusted tariffs, effective 1 July 2017, can be found on the PPCA website.

Relevant licences include but may not be limited to:

- Events and Festivals
- Cinemas (Film Exhibitors) and Legitimate Theatres
- Live Performance Groups and Dance Companies
- Music Events & Festivals
- Music on Hold
- Concert Venues
