## New Major Events Ticket Scalping legislation passed in Victoria

Dear Member

The *Major Events Legislation Amendment (Ticket Scalping and Other Matters) Bill 2017* recently passed through parliament in Victoria. It is anticipated that the Act will commence in mid-2018.

## WHAT'S IN THE LEGISLATION?

- The Major Sporting Events Act 2009 will be renamed the Major Events Act 2009 and expanded to cover declared non-sporting events, including live performances such as concerts, festivals or theatre.
- The VIC Minister for Tourism and Major Events will be able to make a **major event** ticketing declaration for any major event. It is intended to only declare exclusive major and key note events, or events that are requested for declaration by a promoter or event organiser.
- For any event where a major event ticketing declaration applies, it will be an **offence to advertise or resell a ticket for more than 10% above the face value of the ticket**. Penalties range from \$790 to \$475,000 depending on the nature of the offence.
- For any event where a major event ticketing declaration applies, **ticket prices must be displayed on the face of the tickets** to ensure the primary cost of the ticket is clear to consumers.
- **New authorised ticketing officers** will be introduced to support enforcement of the Bill. Along with Victorian police officers they will have the ability to fine ticket scalpers that target declared events.
- The Government will hold stakeholder briefings, information sessions and run a consumer education program on the Act and its rollout.
