



## LPA Summary: **NSW Budget 2018–19**

Dear Member,

As Members may be aware, the New South Wales (NSW) State Budget 2018-19 was handed down yesterday (19 June).

The NSW Budget included the following funding commitments that may benefit the live performance sector:

- \$30m in 2018-19 from the Regional Cultural Fund to support development of arts and cultural activities in regional areas.
- \$245m in 2018-19 as part of the NSW Government's \$645m contribution to build a new Powerhouse museum in Parramatta, and undertake master planning for a creative industries precinct in Ultimo. Minister for the Arts Don Harwin stated that this would include having market soundings for interest in building a 1,500 seat theatre suitable for a range of live performance, including musical theatre.

The NSW Budget 2018-19 also included:

- \$10m as part of a \$55m four-year Mentally Healthy Workplaces strategy, including manager training and recovery at work programs, research to help inform ongoing strategies, a media campaign to raise awareness, and mentoring tools to better support businesses.
- a new Creative Kids rebate to provide families with a \$100 voucher per school-aged child, for extra-curricular activities including music, drama, visual and performing arts, coding and language classes.
