

ACCC concerns about cinema online ticketing practices

Dear Member.

Earlier this week, the ACCC issued a media release stating that Palace Cinemas has paid a penalty of \$10,800 after being issued with an infringement notice. The ACCC had concerns about Palace Cinemas' online pricing practices - specifically that ticket prices and other compulsory fees were not being presented as a total single price during the online booking process.

We would like to remind LPA Members that Australian Consumer Law and the Ticketing Code of Practice requires that:

- price information should be clear, accurate and not misleading
- price information should be represented as a total single price inclusive of all mandatory charges (unless that charge cannot be calculated at the time)
- any additional fees and charges that cannot be reflected in the price need to be disclosed upfront.
