Scott had a successful career working with various theatre companies including Hunter Valley Theatre Company, Sydney Theatre Company, Ensemble Theatre, The Production Company, Manilla Street, Queensland Ballet, Straightjacket Productions, Midsumma, Victorian Opera, Flying Teapot, Opera Hunter, La Mama, Young Dancers Company, Melbourne Opera and Australian Dance Theatre.

Scott has worked across most creative arts disciplines including film & television, theatre production, digital imaging, contemporary dance and motion capture. He worked with

theatre makers, corporate producers and educators as well as developing new works as part of the creative team or producing partners.
