## **LPA Summary: South Australian Budget 2017–18**

26 June 2017

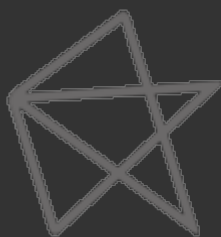
As Members may be aware, the South Australian (SA) Budget was handed down on 22 June 2017. Minister for the Arts Jack Snelling stated that the SA Budget contains almost **\$36 million** in additional funding for arts initiatives that LPA Members may benefit from, including:

- **\$31m** to further expand the scope of the **Her Majesty's Theatre** redevelopment.
- **\$1.1m** to **Arts SA** in 2017-18 for the delivery of arts events, exhibitions and other public programming.
- **\$1m** in 2017-18 for a series of concerts, performances and other **events to mark the completion of the Adelaide Festival Centre redevelopment**.
- **\$1.25m** in 2017-18 in additional funding for the **2018 Adelaide Festival of Arts**.
