



An update on the 2017 PCA

Further to LPA's notice dated 15 September 2016, MEAA has advised that individually processing and registering the 2017 Performers' Collective Agreement ("PCA 2017") for each of LPA's members would not be feasible, due to the timeframe required.

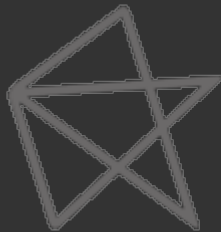
It has therefore been agreed that the PCA 2017 will operate as an informal industry standard and will not be registered with the Fair Work Commission.

Members who currently operate under the current PCA should commence implementing the 2017 PCA, including the new contracts of employment, wages and allowances.
