UPDATE ALLOWANCES SUMMARY AER12

EXHIBITION EMPLOYEE ALLOWANCES:

CLAUSE	ALLOWANCE TYPE	NEW AMOUNT
15.2	Protective clothing and equipment	Reimbursement of protective clothing (oilskins, gumboots, overalls, goggles, safety boots, etc) on proof of purchase unless employer provides them.
15.4	Meal Allowance	\$11.69 or a meal where employee is required to work two or more hours overtime immediately after completing ordinary hours
15.5	First Aid Allowance	\$17.25 per week or \$0.45 per hour where employee appointed to perform first aid duties.
15.6	Uniform Allowance	Reimburse employee for cost of purchase of uniform unless employer supplies uniform. \$1.32 per rostered day up to a maximum of \$6.62 per week where the employee launders their own uniform.
15.7	Transport Allowance	\$0.78 per kilometre where the employer requests the employee to use their own vehicle for travelling on the employer's business.
15.8	Tool Allowance	\$13.52 per week for a Tradesperson (other than a Carpenter) or \$26.37 per week for Carpenters where employee is required to provide their own tools.
