<p>Face masks are mandatory at indoor music festivals with more than 1,000 people.</p> <p>Proof of full vaccination is only required at indoor music festivals with over 1,000 people.</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>There are no density limits for indoor or outdoor settings.</p>	<p>Face masks are recommended for workers who are serving or public facing.</p> <p>Face masks are strongly recommended when unable to physically distance, showing COVID-19 symptoms or interacting with people who may be vulnerable to COVID-19.</p> <p>All patrons and workers must be fully vaccinated unless they have proof of a medical exemption.</p> <p>It is mandatory for every Victorian business with on-site operations to have a COVIDSafe Plan.</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>There are no density limits for indoor or outdoor settings.</p>	<p>Face masks are still recommended when unable to physically distance.</p> <p>Unvaccinated people are unable to attend indoor and outdoor entertainment venues and events unless they have proof of a medical exemption.</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>There are no density limits for indoor or outdoor settings.</p>	<p>Face masks are mandatory for people aged 8 years and over in all indoor settings (apart from the home) and at major stadiums and organised public gatherings.</p> <p>Proof of vaccination is required to enter:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoor entertainment venues (cinemas, theatres, concert halls, live music venues) • Major stadiums • Outdoor music events (above 500 people) • All hospitality venues, food and licensed venues • The entire Crown Perth complex. <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>INDOOR and OUTDOOR</p>	<p>Face masks are required in shared indoor public places for people in South Australia over the age of 12.</p> <p>Some venues (Adelaide Festival Centre, Adelaide Entertainment Centre, Adelaide Oval, Adelaide Convention Centre, and Hindmarsh Stadium) are making it a condition of entry that all persons aged 16+, including staff, are fully vaccinated. Proof of vaccination will be required in order to gain entry. Any person with an official medical exemption will need to provide proof of a negative COVID test result for the 72-hour period prior to seeking entry and full exemption details.</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>INDOOR and OUTDOOR</p>	<p>Face masks are recommended, but not mandatory, for indoor and outdoor events (except for large outdoor events of more than 1000 people).</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>100% of a venue’s seated capacity applies to entertainment venues, stadiums, and arenas plus 1 person per 2 square metres in unseated parts of an otherwise seated venue.</p> <p>All other venues and events are as per the density limit of 1 person per 2 square metres (capacity limit applies).</p> <p>(NB: The updated Framework for COVID-19 Safe Events and Activities applies to venues and events with 251 or more people indoors and venues and</p>	<p>Face masks are strongly encouraged when entering public indoor settings where it could be difficult to maintain physical distancing.</p> <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>There are no density limits for indoor or outdoor settings.</p> <p>All indoor performance venues and live performance events must develop and maintain a COVID Safety Plan. The Plan must be produced if requested by an authorised officer.</p> <p>Organised events of greater than 5,000 people must submit their COVID Safety Plan to ACT Health for review.</p>	<p>Face masks are not required but are recommended.</p> <p>All people must show proof that they are fully vaccinated to enter:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cinemas, theatres, concerts, music and dance halls. • Pubs, clubs and nightclubs • Casinos. <p><u>How many people can attend?</u></p> <p>INDOOR and OUTDOOR</p> <p>There are no capacity restrictions. Events and public gatherings can be held in the Northern Territory subject to physical distancing and hygiene principles being applied to protect the community from any spread of COVID-19.</p>

<p>Large indoor events and venues (including stadiums) that can host 30,000 or more patrons need a one-off approval of their COVIDSafe Major Venue/Event Plan from the Victorian Government through the Public Events Framework approval pathway.
