NT	Tuesday, 9 May 2023	The NT Budget is usually delivered in May, with a 'midcycle update' in December. The 2022-23 Territory Budget was delivered on 12 May 2022.
VIC	Tuesday, 23 May 2023	The Victorian Budget is usually delivered in May, with a 'mid-cycle Budget update' in December. The 2022-23 Victorian Budget was delivered on 3 May 2022.
TAS	Thursday, 25 May 2023	The Tasmanian Budget is usually delivered in May, and the state publishes quarterly updates The 2022-23 Tasmanian Budget was delivered on 26 May.
WA	Expected in May 2023	The WA Budget is usually delivered in May, with a 'mid-year review' in December. The 2022-23 WA Budget was delivered on 12 May 2022.
QLD	Tuesday, 13 June 2023	The Queensland Budget is usually delivered in June, with a 'Mid-Year Fiscal and Economic Review' (MYFR) in December. The 2021-22 Queensland Budget was delivered on 21 June 2022.
ACT	Tuesday, 27 June 2023	The ACT Budget is usually delivered several months after the Commonwealth Budget. The 2022-23 Budget was delivered on 22 August 2022.
NSW	Expected in June 2023	The NSW Budget is usually delivered in June, with a 'mid-cycle update' in December. The 2022-23 NSW State Budget was delivered on 21 June 2022.
SA	Expected in June 2023	The South Australian Budget is usually delivered in June, with a 'mid-year review' in December. The 2022-23 SA Budget was delivered on 2 June 2022.
