UPDATE ALLOWANCES SUMMARY

EXHIBITION EMPLOYEE ALLOWANCES:

CLAUSE	ALLOWANCE TYPE	NEW AMOUNT
18.3(b)	Meal Allowance	\$14.62 or a meal – for overtime of two or more, immediately after completing ordinary hours
18.3(c)	Protective clothing and equipment	Reimbursement of protective clothing (oilskins, gumboots, overalls, goggles, safety boots, etc) on proof of purchase unless employer provides them.
18.2(d)	First Aid Allowance	\$21.37 per week or \$0.56 per hour where employee appointed to perform first aid duties.
18.3(d)(i)	Tool Allowance	\$15.83 per week for Tradesperson (other than a Carpenter)
18.3(d)(ii)		\$30.88 per week for Carpenters where employee is required to provide their own tools.
18.3(e)	Uniform Allowance	Reimburse employee for cost of purchase of uniform unless employer supplies uniform. \$1.32 per rostered day up to a maximum of \$6.62 per week where the
		employee launders their own uniform.
18.3(f)	Vehicle Allowance	\$0.98 per kilometre where the employer requests the employee to use their own vehicle for travelling on the employer's business.
